


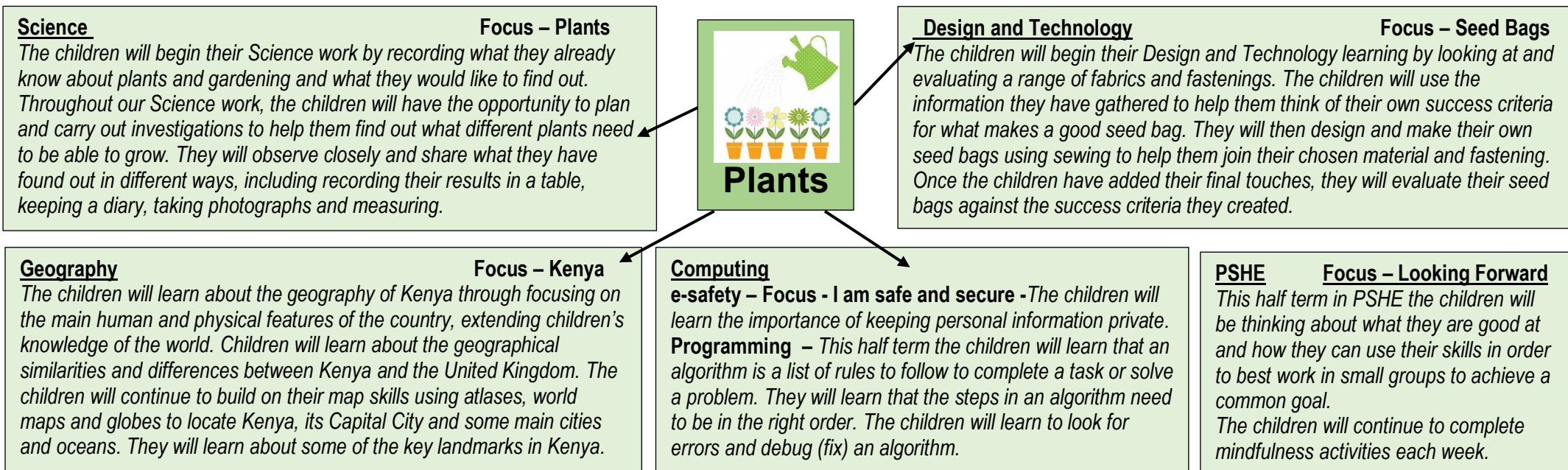





<p><b>Literacy Reading</b></p> 	<p><b>Literacy Writing</b></p> 	<p><b>Maths</b></p> 
<p>Weekly Guided Reading Sessions using the following sequence:  <b>Session 1</b> – Focus on phonics/ decoding words, punctuation, word choice, new vocabulary;  <b>Session 2</b> – Reading the text and comprehension activity;  <b>Session 3</b> – Reading the text and comprehension activity.</p>	<p>This half term our focus will be on non-fiction texts. The children will begin by reading instructions and writing their own instructions. We will then look at explanation texts. The children will look at a range of texts to familiarise themselves with the layout and the type of vocabulary used. At the end of the half term, the children will be encouraged to use what they have learnt to help them write their own explanation texts. During the half term, the children will complete a range of other writing activities. These will include writing bean diaries, letters and captions and completing book reviews.</p>	<p>Our focus for this half term will be on multiplication and division. We will teach multiplication as repeated addition (e.g. <math>4 \times 5 = 5+5+5+5</math>) and the children will use practical objects and jottings to create arrays to help them work out the answers to multiplication number sentences. We will encourage the children to use grouping to help them solve division number sentences. The children will also learn that division is the inverse of multiplication and will use this knowledge to check answers to division number sentences. The children will count in 2s, 5s, and 10s and will begin to count in 3s.</p>
